ELIGIBILITY

The student applying for this scholarship must be from a family, who is a current member of Indiana Farm Bureau, Inc. Additionally, the person must be a high school senior admitted to an approved or accredited school of higher learning and planning to study a minimum of one year as a full-time student.

Ag related majors might include areas such as nutrition, ag research, ag econ, veterinary, ag marketing and other production ag courses.

Carroll County Farm Bureau will be awarding four \$250 scholarships. These will be given to students from Carroll County with one each going to Delphi, Carroll, Rossville, and Twin Lakes School Corporation areas. Home school applicants will be included the school district they live in. If no one applies in a particular area, that scholarship will not be awarded to another area.

Determination to succeed in the student's chosen field

Financial need for scholarship

The applicant or their parents need to be a current Farm Bureau Member
